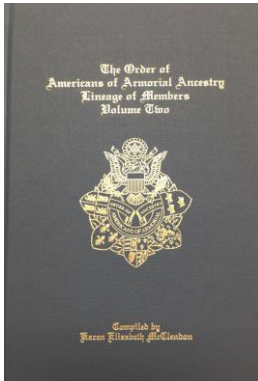


Order of Americans of Armorial

This second volume of OAAA lineages, published in April of 2013, has over 550 pages and a wealth of heraldic information. The foreword, “Heraldry in America: An Introduction,” was written by Duane L. C. M. Galles and contains almost forty pages of fully-sourced information.

The book includes the lineages of 282 members, covering applications 719 through 1000 as well as numerous supplemental lines. An every-name index provides valuable assistance in finding ancestors.

The section on arms contains 244 illustrations by heraldic artist Thomas P. Curtis, approximately 2/3 of which are new in this volume. This section contains a glossary and articles by two recognized authorities in the field: Peter O’Donoghue, York Herald of Arms, “Introduction to Heraldry” and John Mc. Shannon, Executive Director at St. George’s Society of New York, “Rendering the Blazon: Artistic Choice in Depicting Heraldry.”

The cost of the book is \$50.00, including postage and handling.
